Re: Year 10 Science Groupings

I hope that you had a lovely summer holiday. As students begin their GCSE Science courses this September, we have made some changes to the Science class groupings.

These changes have been based on ranking across all Year 9 Assessments but also in discussion with class teachers of whether students are possible triple science, higher tier or foundation tier candidates. This will be reviewed again at the end of Year 10 to decide students' course and tier of entry for Year 11.

Classes 10Sc1 and 10Sc2 will be taught the content for the higher tier and are mixed classes. For some students it may appear they have "moved up or down" – this however is not necessarily the case. Classes 10Sc3 and 10Sc4 will all be taught the content for the foundation tier and are mixed classes.

In Years 10 and 11, students will be taught by three science teachers covering Biology, Chemistry and Physics and will sit six science exams at the end of Year 11.
