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Dear Parent

Thank you to those of you who were able to attend one of the presentations to parents by Mr Hirst, our new Headteacher, on 5 and 6 June 2019.

Further to those presentations I wanted to introduce myself in my new role as Head of School from September and to clarify some of the new information and expectations explained by Mr Hirst on those evenings.

Uniform

From September 2019 there is a new uniform for all incoming Year 7s, which comprises of a navy blue blazer with red flashes and lining (in a male and female shape), a grey compulsory school skirt or grey formal trousers, worn with black or grey tights or black socks and formal black shoes.

For all pupils who will be in Years 8-11 from September 2019 the new blazer is optional but will be the only one available to order, should your child require a replacement for their current black one.

All pupils in all year groups are expected to wear grey formal trousers (in either slim, standard or comfort fit) or the new grey school skirt (purchased directly through the school shop), along with black socks or black or grey tights.

All pupils are expected to wear formal black shoes, not trainers, pumps, branded sports shoes, etc.

Parents should ensure their child attends school in the correct uniform. Should your child not arrive at school correctly dressed, they may be sent home in order to change into the correct uniform.

In cases of financial hardship including, but not limited to, certain benefits, uniform may be subsidised on application to the school's Learner Support Fund. If you believe you may be eligible to apply for such subsidies please do not hesitate to contact the school office.

Attendance & Behaviour Expectations

All pupils are expected to attend school at all times, barring exceptional circumstances, and to adhere to the school rules. Please be sure to read the Attendance letter and leaflet that will be sent home in September confirming attendance expectations and procedures, as per the Norfolk and National guidance.

Please be aware of the Term Dates 2019-2020. The West Norfolk Academies Trust is <u>not</u> following the Norfolk Model, so please look closely at the enclosed term date calendar, **noting especially that 4**September is for Year 7 only. 5 September will be the first day of term for all other year groups.

Learning

- I will allow my child to go on school field and residential

- I will make certain that my child attends school every day, except in cases of illness or another legitimate reason.
- If my child is absent, I will telephone the school before 8.15 am on the day of absence to report why my child is absent and provide a letter to explain their absence on the first day of their return.

Student

- I will arrive at school before 8.30am.
- I will always work, think and behave in the best way I know how, and I will try my hardest for my peers and myself to learn.
- I will speak to my teachers if I do not understand something.
- I will complete my homework to the best of my ability and hand it in on time.
- I will discuss any problems I am having at school with my parents, teachers and pastoral staff.

I will contribute to a safe and respectful community by the following:

- I will wear the correct uniform smartly every day.
 I will keep my electronic devices out of sight and switched off and understand that they will be confiscated if they are seen or heard anywhere in the school. I also understand that the school takes no responsibility for their safekeeping.
- I agree to abide by the school's code of conduct and understand that there will be consequences if I fail to do so.
- I will conduct myself in line with the school's values, both in and out of school, as I accept that as a student at the school I am an ambassador at all times.
- I will always treat everyone at Smithdon High School with respect. I will always listen to and care for my peers.
- I am responsible for my own behaviour.

I believe I am capable of academic and personal success. I am ready to do whatever it takes to realise my full potential.

 We promise to welcome parents into the school community.

Behaviour

- We will reinforce Smithdon High School values consistently and fairly.
- We will protect students from poor behaviour by insisting on high standards and holding students to account for their actions.

- I will always make myself available to the school by providing an up to date phone number and contact details.
- I will communicate with the school in a timely and polite manner, in line with the school's values.

Discipline

- I have understood Smithdon High School's consequences for misbehaviour.
- I understand that detentions usually happen on the day that they are given and that the standard detention will last for half an hour.
- I understand that my child cannot be excused from after school detentions and, if necessary, I will make arrangements to collect my child from school after the detention.
