

Smithdon High School Uniform

The following items should be worn:

- Black blazer with school badge embroidered on the breast pocket (from school supply)
- Black school tie with coloured stripe according to year (from school supply)
- Black trousers in a traditional style – no cords, jeans, linens, hipsters, skinny, flared bootleg or 'ankle grazer' trousers
- Plain white shirt
- Black V-neck jumper with school badge (optional)
- Plain black socks
- Black school shoes – no trainers or shoes with sports logos; no high heels, platforms, sling backs or backless shoes (advisory maximum heel height 5cm)
- Outdoor coats (to and from school).

Options for Girls

- Plain black knee-length skirt (school skirts available for purchase from school)
- Plain black tights

Please note:

The following must not appear:

- Casual sweatshirts, hooded sweatshirts, denim or leather jackets
- Unnatural hair colours and extreme hairstyles
- Facial piercings of any kind
- Ear 'tunnels', rings and bars – only a single pair of small studs (one in each ear lobe) will be permitted
- Temporary 'tattoos'
- Acrylic (or other artificial) nails
- Bare ankles
- Make-up
- Jewellery (excluding watches) – no rings, bracelets or necklaces
- Hats (in the school building)
