I am writing to inform you that your child has the opportunity to a place on our Year 10 Maths Mentoring Programme. The sessions will involve working one to one with a current A Level student who is both fluent at GCSE Maths and familiar with the new GCSE course.

The main purpose of these sessions is to provide targeted support for your child, which will aid their progress and help them to achieve their target grade.

Due to the high demand for the programme, it is essential that we have 100% commitment from the students. If your son or daughter is not engaging with the support or not attending, then unfortunately the opportunity will be offered to another student.

There will be three sessions between 9am and 12pm, commencing Saturday 17 June. The duration of each session will be 60 minutes, which will be supervised by myself.

Students are to report to E-block, via the gate at D-block staff car park, at least five minutes prior to their designated time slot. Students are not required to wear school uniform, but will need to bring all necessary maths equipment (including pens, pencils, rulers, compass and their own scientific calculator) and any revision guides.

As places are limited, they will be based on a 'first come, first served' basis, although we are hoping to extend and have more places available in September, so if your child is unsuccessfully initially, please be assured that we will endeavour to accommodate them with a future session.
