Re: Year 10 Reports

The report includes:

- · your child's Attitude to Learning Grade
- a Test Percentage for the recent exams (No exam percentage is recorded where absence prevented a student from completing the exam)
- a Target Minimum Grade, which is calculated based on Key Stage 2 performance (this is the minimum grade that we would expect students to achieve given expected rates of progress from Key Stage 2).
- a Predicted Grade, which is the grade we would expect your child to achieve in the final exams, given their current rate of progress.

Grades are given with a sub-grade (a, b or c). A sub-grade of 'a' means that the student's grade is secure; a sub-grade of 'b' means that this is the probable grade and a sub-grade of 'c' means that grade is currently insecure.
