Dear Parents

In what are challenging circumstances, the students and parents of the Smithdon community have remained upbeat and positive with regards to home learning and student outcomes.

Whilst year 7-10 students engage with the curriculum at home, year 11 students should now be giving consideration to their next steps. Colleges and sixth form institutions are now contacting students and parents with regards to expectations from this point on. It is vitally important that students maintain as much momentum as possible in the summer term and endeavour to make progress with independent research, reading materials, and summer tasks where completion will be expected.

As per government guidelines, the students that do not achieve a grade 4 in English or Mathematics will be expected to continue with these subjects from September. Please ensure that your child sets aside an appropriate amount of time each week for this work to take place.
